What is an SQA Advanced Diploma?

The SQA Advanced Diploma is an internationally recognised Higher Education qualification. It has been designed by SQA to help students enter the workplace. It is also ideal for students who would like to move on to a related degree programme in China or overseas.

The SQA Advanced Diploma is powerful and respected. It is equivalent to an associate degree and develops high-level skills and knowledge.

Why should I study for an SQA Advanced Diploma?

The SQA Advanced Diploma is affordable, career-focused and delivered by experts. If you are intending to work abroad, or if you would like to study for a degree at an English-speaking university, the diploma is especially useful.

Building your skills

An established presence in China

SQA has worked alongside Chinese Service Centre for Scholarly Exchange (CSCSE) since 2003. This close relationship allows SQA to support the staff directly at our China-based universities. The diploma programme is the largest foreign higher education programme in China.

The partnership also ensures the SQA Advanced Diploma is being delivered to the same high standards at each of our Chinese universities.

What is the format of an SQA Advanced Diploma?

Each SQA Advanced Diploma has been designed with involvement from universities, employers, students and professional bodies. This makes sure that the most useful and relevant subjects are studied in the most practical ways.

Diplomas are studied over three years

- Year 1: a locally designed Foundation year builds your English-language skills – essential for university entry
- Years 2 & 3: two years to complete your SQA Advanced Diploma

Each diploma is made up of separate Units – usually you will study 30 Units

- You will study between six and eight Units each term
- Each Unit consists of approximately 40 hours of learning and teaching
- Each Unit is taught and assessed using a mix of research, project, case studies, group work and practical work
- In year 1 of your diploma you will sit a Graded Unit assessment
- In year 2 you will sit either one or two Graded Unit assessments. The number of year 2 assessments will depend on the subject you are studying
- Different subjects are assessed in different ways. Your Graded Unit assessment could take the form of an examination, a case study, an investigation or a practical assignment

Result grades are shown in the table below
