Conference Speakers

Iverene Bromfield, Senior External Verifier English and Communication

Iverene has been involved in teaching and assessing English and Communication qualifications for over 30 years and has been an external verifier for almost 20 years. She has contributed to the development of a wide range of resources including new unit specifications, assessment support packs, Understanding Standards Exemplars, and other guidance documents supporting assessors in the UK, and internationally. She has been involved in external verification activity in China since 2015 and has visited most SQA centres across China. She has delivered online webinars to support the delivery and assessment of Communication and Research Skills units.

Gillian Hepburn, Head of International, Business Development

Gillian is SQA's Head of International and has a proven track record of successful collaboration through multi-partnership working in both public and private sectors. She now leads a team of International Regional Managers who focus on exporting SQA's high quality qualifications & education services across the globe. Before becoming Head of International, Gillian led SQA's strategic activity across England, Wales and Ireland.

This will be her third trip to China, her previous two trips focusing on engagement with CSCSE, Beijing Yinhong and meeting with many of SQA's approved centres throughout the country.

Conference Speakers

Robert Quinn, Head of Service Qualifications Development

Robert leads a large team responsible for the development and maintenance of an extensive range of SQA qualifications in English, Languages and Business. Before joining SQA, he spent 10 years as a lecturer and senior lecturer in Business education and several years in the private sector working in Management Consultancy. Robert first visited China in 2006 as an external verifier and since visited China many times to work with centres and our partners CSCSE and Beijing Yinghong, and to deliver the professional development conferences. His main interest outside work is endurance running and cycling and he has won several national titles throughout his running career.

Iain Walker, Senior External Verifier Business

lain worked in the education sector at the University of the Highlands and Islands for 30 years, after which he joined SQA as a Qualification Implementation Manager. He has been the senior external verifier for Business and Economics for over 15 years and has managed and contributed to a wide range of qualifications-related projects for SQA in the general Business subject area. He has been involved in verification activity in China and has presented at a wide range of centre staff training events, including all the past professional development conferences. His focus in recent years has been acting as a primary verifier at Chinese verification events and he continues to work closely with centres internationally to provide support to their staff in the delivery and assessment of SQA awards.

Jimmy Zhang, In-Country Manager, China

Jimmy has worked on SQA's Diploma programmes since 2008. He gained his first experience of the programme while employed at Beijing Jiaotong University and he built on this with a move to Beijing Yinghong and our partners in China. This experience was a crucial factor in Jimmy's appointment as SQA's China In-Country Manager in April 2016. He works closely with SQA's centres, partners and internal departments to deliver high quality support for the SQA Advanced Diploma programme, and liaises across SQA teams to ensure the programme runs smoothly.

Zhou Qin (Corrine), Shanghai University of Finance and Economics

Qin (Corrine) Zhou joined the SQA HND (AD) program in September 2004 and was one of the first batch of Business subject teachers in China. Over the past 20 years, Qin has been held a variety of roles: a Graded Units instructor since 2005; continuous contributor of teaching programmes for new units and new teachers; produced 24 assessment papers for 12 unit courses prior verified and accepted by SQA; appointed by CSCSE to deliver a presentation on "Successful Delivery Methods (student-centred) Used for HND Programmes" to the SQA Executive Team at Shanghai University of Finance and Economics (SUFE) in 2005, and appointed as an in-country external verifier from 2007 to 2015 by SQA.

In addition, she has been a nationwide class demonstration winner, the event of which was organised by CSCSE-Yinhong in May 2008; awarded 8 times International Education College, SUFE best teacher of the semester and 4 times annual ideal teacher; awarded CSCSE-SQA Advanced Diploma Programme Quality Endorsed Units by CSCSE-Yinhong in 2020, 2021 and 2022, and awarded CSCSE-SQA Advanced Diploma Programme Excellent Teacher by CSCSE-Yinhong in 2021.
